BEING CONSISTENT IN CHANGING TIMES. Sunday, June 9th, 2024 Pastor Audie D. Clairmont

1. WE NEED TO BE <u>UNCHANGINGLY FAITHFUL</u> TO GOD THROUGH TRIALS.

James 1:2-4- NKJV

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,

- 3 knowing that the *testing of your faith <u>produces patience</u>*.
- 4 But *let patience have its perfect work*, that you may be *perfect and complete*, *lacking nothing*.

Patience literally means *perseverance*, *persistence*, *endurance*, *staying power*; *to be consistently constant or* <u>to be the same way all the time, regardless of what</u> <u>happens.</u> A person unchangingly faithful and dependable.

Hebrews 6:11-15-CJB

11However, we want *each one of you to keep showing the same <u>diligence right up</u> <u>to the end</u>,*

when your hope will be realized.

12 so that you will not <u>become sluggish</u>, but will be imitators of those who by their <u>trust and patience</u> are receiving what has been promised.

13 For when God made his promise to Avraham, he swore an oath to do what he had promised; and since there was no one greater than himself for him to swear by, he swore by himself

14 and said, "I will certainly bless you, and I will certainly give you many descendants";

15 and so, after *waiting patiently*, Avraham saw *the promise fulfilled*.

Amplified Bible: ...having waited long and endured patiently, ...

KIV: ...Patiently endure - to be of a long spirit, not to lose heart; to persevere patiently and bravely in enduring misfortunes and troubles; to be patient in bearing the offenses and injuries of others.

Endurance: power of enduring an unpleasant or difficult process or situation *without giving way.*

2. WE NEED TO BE <u>CONSISTENT</u> IN OUR <u>TRUST</u> IN THE <u>UNCHANGING</u> WORD OF GOD.

Hebrews 10:35-36-NKJV

Therefore, do not *cast away your confidence*, which has great reward. 36 ...KJV-...*For ye have need of patience*, that, after ye have done the will of God, *ye might receive the promise.* CJB-...*for you need to hold out...*

Amplified Bible:For you have need of steadfast patience and endurance, ...

Confidence: the feeling or belief that one can rely on someone or something; firm trust; the state of feeling certain about the truth of something.

Patience (or being consistently constant) is the *power twin of faith/trust*. They work together to see to it the promises of God are fulfilled in your life.

3. WE NEED TO ALLOW *HIS* PATIENCE IN US <u>TO GROW.</u>

Luke 21:19-KJV In your *patience* possess ye *your souls.*

2Corinthians 10:5-Webster

... Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and *bringing into captivity every thought* to the obedience of Christ; ...

Message: ...We use our powerful God-tools for smashing warped philosophies, tearing down barriers erected against the truth of God, *fitting every loose thought* and *emotion* and *impulse into the structure of life shaped by Christ.*

James 1:4 - "LET patience have her perfect work..."

James 1:13 – KJV

... Let no man say when he is tempted (tested), I am tempted (tested) of God:

James 1:12 – ESV

Blessed is the man <u>who remains steadfast</u> under trial, for when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.

NLT - James 1:3-4... For you know that when your faith is tested, your *endurance* has a chance to grow. 4 So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing.
