## PRAYERS THAT DEMOLISH MOUNTAINS

I speak to every mountain in my life and command it to be removed and cast into the sea (Mark 11:23).

I speak to every financial mountain to be removed from my life in the name of Jesus.

I prophesy to the mountains and command them to hear the Word of the Lord and be removed (Ezek. 36:4).

Let the mountains tremble at the presence of God (Hab. 3:10).

I contend with every mountain and command them to hear my voice (Mic. 6:1).

Put forth Your hand, O Lord, and overturn the mountains by the roots (Job 28:9).

I speak to every mountain of debt to be removed and cast into the sea. Lord, you are against every destroying mountain (Jer. 51:25).

Let the mountains melt at Your presence, O God (Judg. 5:5, KJV).

Make waste the evil mountains in my life, O Lord (Isa. 42:15).

I thresh every mountain, I beat them small, and I make the hills as chaff (Isa. 41:15).

Every mountain in my way will become a plain (Zech. 4:7).

# Mark 11:23-24-NKJV

23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

24 Therefore I say to you, *whatever things <u>you ask</u> when you pray*, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*.

**NLT** - ... I tell you the truth, <u>you can say to this mountain</u>, 'May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' and it will happen. But you must really believe it will happen and <u>have no doubt in your heart.</u>

I tell you, *you can pray for anything*, and if *you believe that <u>you've received it</u>*, it will be yours.

#### Matthew 21:21-NKJV

So, Jesus answered and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you<u>, if you have faith and do not doubt,</u> you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' it will be done.

The **English - doubt** comes from the Latin *dubitare*, which is rooted in an Aryan word meaning "two."

Hebrew -tala (taw-law) — to mentally stay in hesitation, to be uncertain, Indecision, wavering - back and forth, lack of trust.

# 1Kings 18:21-TLV

Then Elijah approached all the people and said, "How long will you waver between two opinions? If Adonai is God, follow Him; but if Baal is, follow him."

#### James 1:6-AMP

Only it must be <u>in faith that he asks with no wavering (no hesitating, no doubting).</u> For the one who <u>wavers (hesitates, doubts)</u> is like the billowing surge out at sea that is blown hither and thither and tossed by the wind.

# Luke 10:19-the Scriptures

19 Remember, <u>I have given you authority</u>; so, you can trample down snakes and scorpions, indeed, <u>all the Enemy's forces; and you will remain</u> completely unharmed.

#### Luke 9:1-2-AMP.

1 THEN JESUS called together the Twelve [apostles] and <u>gave them</u> power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases,
2 And He sent them out to announce and preach the kingdom of God

#### 1John 3:8-AMP

and to bring healing.

8 ...The reason the Son of God was made manifest (visible) was to <u>undo (destroy,</u> loosen, and dissolve) the works the devil [has done].

## Matthew 6:10-CJB

6 May your Kingdom come; your will be done on earth as in heaven.

# 2. MOVING MOUNTAINS IN OUR LIVES COMES WITH <u>DECREEING</u> AND DECLARING THE PROMISES OF GOD.

**Decree -** an official order issued by a legal authority. Command, proclamation.

**Declare** - to reveal, voice, articulate, express, set forth, publicize, shout from the rooftops.

John 19:30 - ...He said, "It is finished!" (tetelestai)...

Tetelestai - To declare a thing, is to decree that ALL HAS BEEN ACCOMPLISHED!

#### Job 22:28-AMP

28 You shall also decide and <u>decree a thing</u>, and <u>it shall be established</u> <u>for you;</u> and the light [of God's favor] shall shine upon your ways.

#### Isaiah 42:9-AMP.

9 Behold, the former things have come to pass, and <u>new things I now</u> <u>declare; before they spring forth I tell you of them.</u>

#### Romans 4:17-NIRV

...The God that Abraham believed in gives life to the dead. *Abraham's God also speaks of things that do not exist as if they do exist.* 

# Romans 10:8-the Scriptures

But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart"—that is, the word of belief which we are proclaiming: ...

# Joshua 1:8-The Scriptures
