MOVE THAT MOUNTAIN Sunday, November 10th, 2024 Audie Clairmont

Mark 11:14-NKJV

In response Jesus said to it, "Let no one eat fruit from you ever again." And His disciples heard it.

Mark 11:17-NKJV

..."Is it not written, 'MY HOUSE SHALL BE CALLED A HOUSE OF PRAYER FOR ALL NATIONS'? But you have made it a 'DEN OF THIEVES."

Mark 11:20-24

- 20 Now in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.
- **21** And Peter, remembering, said to Him, "Rabbi, look! The fig tree which You cursed has withered away."
- 22 So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God.
- 23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and *does not doubt in his heart*, but *believes* that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.
- **24** Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*.

We cannot move any <u>mountains</u> in our lives until the major mountain of <u>DOUBT AND UNBELIEF</u> IS MOVED FIRST!

Matthew 14:27-29-NKJV

- 27 But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid."
- **28** And Peter answered Him and said, "Lord, *if it is You*, command me to come to You on the water."
- **29** So He said, "Come." And when Peter had come down out of the boat, he walked on the water to go to Jesus.

Matthew 14:30

- 30 **But when he saw that the wind was boisterous**, he was **afraid**; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, "Lord, save me!"
- **31** And *immediately* Jesus stretched out *His* hand and caught him, and said to him, *"O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"*

When crisis comes, remember the <u>answered prayer</u> you received in the past <u>with your faith.</u>

2Chronicles 14:11

And Asa cried out to the LORD his God, and said, "LORD, it is nothing for You to help, whether with many or with those who have no power; help us, O LORD our God, for we rest on You, and in Your name we go against this multitude. O LORD, you are our God; do not let man prevail against You!"

2Chronicles15:1

- 1 Now the Spirit of God came upon Azariah the son of Oded.
- 2 And he went out to meet Asa, and said to him: "Hear me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin. <u>The LORD is with you while you are with Him. If you seek Him, He will be</u> found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will forsake you.

2Chronicles 16:7-9

And at that time **Hanani the seer** came to Asa king of Judah, and said to him: "Because you have relied on the king of Syria, and have not relied on the LORD your God, therefore the army of the king of Syria has escaped from your hand. **8** Were the Ethiopians and the Lubim not a huge army with very many chariots and horsemen? *Yet, because you relied on the LORD, He delivered them into your hand.*

9 For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, **to show Himself strong on behalf of those whose heart is loyal to Him.** In this you have done foolishly; therefore from now on you shall have wars."

The hardest part of faith is the final half hour.

Verse 23-24 ... <u>whoever says</u> to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and <u>does not doubt in his heart</u>, but <u>believes that those things he says</u> will be done, he will have whatever he says.

We have to learn to lay down <u>our own desires</u>, and let God give us what <u>He</u> <u>desires for us</u>.

Matthew 26:38-39

Then He said to them, "My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here and watch with Me."

39 He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, "O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; <u>nevertheless</u>, <u>not as I will, but as You</u> will."
