The Road to Hope Sunday, December 1st, 2024 Audie Clairmont

The word **hope** means **an** <u>expectation</u> of something good or something you desire.

Proverbs 13:12-NKJV

Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but when the desire comes, it is a tree of life.

Passion-12When hope's dream seems to drag on and on, <u>the delay can be</u> <u>depressing</u>. But when at last your dream comes true, life's sweetness will satisfy your soul.

Hebrews 6:11-Passion

But we long to see you passionately advance <u>until the end</u> and <u>you find your hope</u> <u>fulfilled.</u>

Romans 15:13-AMP

May <u>the God of your hope</u> so fill you with *all joy and peace* <u>in believing</u> [through the experience of your faith] that <u>by the power of the Holy Spirit</u> you <u>may abound</u> and be overflowing (bubbling over) with hope.

WE HAVE HOPE BECAUSE OF OUR RIGHT STANDING WITH THE LORD.

Romans 5:1-5-NKJV

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

- 2 through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
- **3** And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance;
- 4 and perseverance, character; and character, hope.
- **5** Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Romans 4:6-7-Passion

- 6 Even King David himself speaks to us regarding the complete wholeness that comes inside a person when God's powerful declaration of righteousness is heard over our life. Apart from our works, *God's work is enough*.
- 7 Here's what David says: What happy fulfillment is ahead for those whose rebellion has been forgiven and whose sins are covered by blood.

THE ROAD TO HOPE GOES THROUGH TRIBULATION AND AFFLICTION.

Rom. 5:2-3 2 ...and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. 3 And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations,...

1Peter 4:12-13-Passion

12 Beloved friends, if life gets extremely difficult, with many tests, don't be bewildered as though something strange were overwhelming you.

13 Instead, <u>continue to rejoice</u>, for you, in a measure, have shared in the sufferings of the Anointed One <u>so that you can share in the revelation of his glory and celebrate with even greater gladness!</u>

Romans 15:5-AMP

Now may the <u>God Who gives the power of patient endurance (steadfastness) and Who supplies encouragement,</u> grant you to live in such <u>mutual harmony and such full sympathy with one another</u>, in accord with Christ Jesus, ...

THE ROAD TO HOPE GOES THROUGH CHARACTER, OR EXPERIENCE.

Rom. 5:4...<u>Perseverance</u> brings about character Passion...And *patient endurance* will *refine our character*, ...

Act 27:20-NKJV

Now when neither sun nor stars appeared for many days, and no small tempest beat on *us*, *all hope that we would be saved was finally given up*.

Philippians 1:21-24-Passion

21 My true life is the Anointed One, and dying means gaining more of him. 22-24 So here's my dilemma: Each day I live means bearing more fruit in my ministry; yet I fervently long to be liberated from this body and joined fully to Christ. That would suit me fine, but the greatest advantage to you would be that I remain alive. So, you can see why I'm torn between the two—I don't know which I prefer.

Romans 8:24-25-Passion

- 24 For this is the hope of our salvation. But **hope means** that <u>we must trust and</u> <u>wait for what is still unseen.</u> For why would we need to hope for something we already have?
- **25** So because our hope is set on what is yet to be seen, <u>we patiently keep on</u> waiting for its fulfillment.
