Hebrews 10:24-CJB

And let us keep paying attention to one another, in order to spur each other on to love and good deeds, ...

spur - moving toward someone... to move them forward.

“consider” - means paying intense attention as to how we go about ...spurring someone forward.

Hebrews 10:24-Passion

Discover creative ways to encourage others and to motivate them toward acts of compassion, doing beautiful works as expressions of love.

Aramaic says, “Let us look on one another with the excitement of love.”

Heb 10:24-25-CJB

And let us keep paying attention to one another, in order to spur each other on to love and good deeds, not neglecting our own congregational meetings, as some have made a practice of doing, but, rather, encouraging each other. And let us do this all the more as you see the Day Approaching.

LEB - not abandoning our meeting together, as is the habit of some...abandon. - Greek implies a person who is extremely discouraged.

Passion-This is not the time to pull away and neglect meeting together, as some have formed the habit of doing, because we need each other! In fact, we should come together even more frequently, eager to encourage and urge each other onward as we anticipate that day dawning.

BEFORE I SPUR SOMEONE FORWARD IN THE LORD, MAKE SURE I AM MOVING FORWARD IN MY WALK WITH GOD.

Galatians 6:1 (NKJV)

1 Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.

Passion - My beloved friends, if you see a believer who is overtaken with a fault, may the one who overflows with the Spirit seek to restore him. Win him over with gentle words, which will open his heart to you and will keep you from exalting yourself over him.

Matthew 7:4-NKJV, Jesus said,

4 Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me remove the speck from your eye'; and look, a plank is in your own eye?

John 8:7-NKJV

7 ... "He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first."

You cannot spur people on with just words; you have to show it with your life.

BEFORE I SPUR SOMEONE FORWARD IN THE LORD, MAKE SURE THE TIMING IS RIGHT.

Romans 5:6 - NIV

6 You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly.

Passion - For when the time was right, the Anointed One came and died to demonstrate his love for sinners who were entirely helpless, weak, and powerless to save themselves.

Romans 13:11 -NIV

11 And do this, understanding the present time. The hour has come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed.

Passion - To live like this is all the more urgent, for time is running out and you know it is a strategic hour in human history. It is time for us to wake up! For our full salvation is nearer now than when we first believed.

Proverbs 27:6 - NIV

6 Wounds from a friend can be trusted...

Passion - You can trust a friend who wounds you with his honesty, ...

BEFORE I SPUR SOMEONE FORWARD IN THE LORD, BE SENSITIVE TO THE HOLY SPIRIT TO LEAD YOU IN WHAT TO SAY.

Luke 12:11-12 (NIV)

11 "When you are brought before synagogues, rulers and authorities, do not worry about how you will defend yourselves or what you will say,

12 for the Holy Spirit will teach you at that time what you should say."

Romans 2:4-Passion

Do the riches of his extraordinary kindness make you take him for granted and despise him? Haven't you experienced how kind and understanding he has been to you?
